

## Testing Sheet for Eucharist

### Questions for First Eucharist

1. Understanding: The child should be able to correctly answer the following questions:
  - a. What does the bread at Mass change into? (*Body of Christ*) What does the wine at Mass change into? (*Blood of Christ*)
  - b. Who has the power to act in the place of Christ at Mass? (The priest) What happens when Father says the words "This is my Body?" (*The bread becomes the Body of Christ*)
  - c. What happens when Father says the words "This is my Blood?" (*The wine becomes the Blood of Christ*)
  - d. Name the four ways Jesus is present to us at Mass. (*The people at Mass, the Word read to us in the Bible, the priest, and the consecrated bread and wine*)
  - e. What is the first part of the Mass called? (*The Liturgy of the Word*) What is the second part of the Mass called? (*The Liturgy of the Eucharist*)
  
2. Mass Responses: The child should be able to correctly respond to the following phrases.
  - a. Penitential Rite: *Lord have mercy, Christ have mercy, Lord, have mercy.*
  - b. For the Readings at Mass: (The Word of the Lord.) *Thanks be to God.*
  - c. For the Gospel: (The Gospel of the Lord.) *Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ.*
  - d. For the Prayer of the Faithful:  
(We pray to the Lord...) *Lord, hear our prayer.*
  - e. For the beginning of the Eucharistic Prayer:  
(The Lord be with you.) *And also with you.*  
(Lift up your hearts.) *We have lifted them up to the Lord.*  
(Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.) *It is right to give him thanks and praise.*
  - f. To remember Jesus in the Eucharistic prayer:  
(Let us proclaim the mystery of faith.) *Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again.*
  - g. At the Kiss of Peace  
(The peace of the Lord be always with you.) *And also with you.*
  - h. At Communion: (Body of Christ.) *Amen.*
  - i. At the end of Mass:  
(Go in peace to love and serve the Lord.) *Thanks be to God.*
  
3. Knowledge of the Mass: The child should know the two divisions of the Mass and what ritual is in each part:
  - a. Liturgy of the Word: Introductory Rites Readings, Gospel, Homily, Prayer of the Faithful.
  - b. Liturgy of the Eucharist: Bring up the gifts of bread and wine to the altar, Eucharistic Prayer, Our Father, the Kiss of Peace, Communion, Concluding Rites.
